

Playins are held for grades 5-8 grade Boys and Girls Teams.

The winner of the district playins for Volleyball represents the St. Charles District in the Archdiocesan Championships.

Sometimes an extra team is selected by the Archdiocese as a wild card. This is not guaranteed, but if St. Charles County is awarded a wild card slot it would be the second-place team of the District Playins.

St. Charles District Volleyball teams play 30 games in their league. The team with the most wins in their league will be the league champion. St. Charles District does **not** use the “match record” to determine playoff teams.

Here are the guidelines for team selected to participate in St. Charles County Playins:

If there is ONLY 1 league in a division / gender there will be a playoff of the top two teams for open and closed. The winner of the two team playoff advances to the Archdiocesan playoffs.

Note: North County Boys games will not count when determining the playoff teams. Highest winning percentage of St. Charles District (Boys) vs St. Charles District (Boys) games.

When there is more than one league in a division / gender for open divisions:

- Blue Division Top 4 Places
- Red Division Top 3 Places
- White, Gold, Silver Top 2 Places
- Bronze Division Top Place Only

When there is more than one league in a division / gender for closed divisions:

- Blue Division Top 4 Places
- Red Division Top 3 Places
- White, Gold, Silver, and Bronze Top 2 Places

Once teams are selected for the district volleyball tournament, open and closed teams are seeded according to the league / placement (not the record they had in their league.) The seeding is as follows Blue division 1-4 Seeds, Red Division 5,6 and 9 Seeds, White Division 7 and 8 Seeds, Gold Divisions 10 and 11 Seeds, Silver Division 12 and 13 Seeds and Bronze Division 14 and 15 Seeds. **Seedings will be adjusted if there is no eligible team for the above divisional places.**

All Parochial Teams will be placed in the St. Charles District Playins. The winner of the Playins will be the St. Charles District representative for the Archdiocesan Championships.

Teams play best two of three games to advance to the next round of St. Charles County Playins.. **For all St. Charles District Playin matches, each set will be played to 25 with a cap of 27.** The playins will use CYC rules and St. Charles District Volleyball Supplemental Rules. The winner of the championship game advances to the Archdiocesan playoffs.
